The 2019 elections to the Board of Tonbridge Angels Football Club will take place in the coming weeks and this is an opportunity for our owners to stand for election to the Board and for members to vote if the number of candidates exceeds the number of places available.

Please complete the following nomination form if you have the time, energy, patience and skills which you think can take our club forwards as we pursue our vision by:-

- Enhancing the social, cultural and economic value of the Club to its Communities and by acting as a responsible custodian of the club for future generations;
- Upholding the mutual ownership of the club operating democratically, fairly, and transparently;
- Ensuring the Club operates with financial responsibility enabling the Club to be run for the long term interest of the Community;
- Providing sporting facilities and opportunities regardless of age, income, ethnicity, gender, disability, sexuality, religious or moral belief; and
- Playing at the highest level possible, but always operating in a financially responsible and prudent manner.

Once completed you will need to ask three TAFC members to second the nomination form, and you may submit up to 1,000 words to support your candidacy. If the number of candidates exceeds the number of places available there will an election with ballot papers sent to paid up members together with the AGM notice. The intention is to announce the results of any election at the **AGM on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November, 2019**.

### **Person Specification**

Board Meetings take place monthly, with ad-hoc meetings taking place in between as and when necessary. Board members are expected to attend as many as possible, together with any sub-committees set up from time to time to focus on single aspects of the Club. Board members may also be expected to represent the Club at external meetings and to represent the Club on match days.
