Please complete the following nomination form if you have the time, energy, patience, commitment and skills which you think can take our club forwards as we pursue our core values by: -

- enhancing the social, cultural and economic value of the Club to its Communities and by acting as a responsible custodian of the club for future generations;
- upholding the mutual ownership of the Club operating democratically, fairly and transparently;
- ensuring the Club operates with financial responsibility enabling the Club to be run for the long-term interest of the Community;
- providing sporting facilities and opportunities regardless of age, income, ethnicity, gender, disability, sexuality, religious or moral belief; and
- playing at the highest level possible, but always operating in a financially responsible and prudent manner.

Once completed, you will also need to ask **three** T AFC Owners to second the nomination form, and you should submit up to 1,000 words to support your candidacy.

If the number of candidates exceeds the number of places available there will be an election with ballot papers sent to paid up members together with an AGM notice. If there are as many or fewer candidates than there are places, an affirmative ballot shall be held at the AGM. Each successfully nominated candidate will be put before the meeting for the approval of members. Any candidate not receiving the support of more than half of those present in person and by proxy shall be deemed to have not been elected. The exception shall be that should the failure to elect any of the validly nominated candidates leave the Board below the minimum required under the Rules for them to act, all validly nominated candidates shall be deemed elected this declared at the AGM. The intention is to announce the results of any election at the **AGM on Friday 16th July, 2021**.

Person Specification

A passion for all things Tonbridge Angels is obviously a great starting point together with a good understanding of how non-league semi-professional football is organised and financed in England.

The Board requires various specific skill sets to function properly and whilst we wouldn't wish to exclude any of our members from the election process, in your completed nomination form it would be helpful to see what examples of those skills and experience

that you would be bringing to the Board. As an example of this a knowledge of the legal world is one area that would be particularly valuable.

Board Meetings take place monthly on normally the second Monday of each month, with ad-hoc meetings taking place in between as and when necessary. Board members are expected to attend these meetings, together with any sub-committees set up from time to time that may focus on single aspects of the Club. Board members may also be expected to represent the Club at external meetings and to represent the Club on home and away match days.

Successful candidates will need to sign a copy of The Board Membership Conduct Policy to indicate they understand that policy and will comply. The policy includes a section on confidentiality. In addition, a DBS Certificate will need to be obtained.
